## General Reminder on School Picnic

- 1. School Picnic is a school day, all students must attend. Student who cannot attend the activity or come back should stay in school for self-study.
- 2. For students who need to take casual leave, they must apply in writing prior to the school.
- 3. For students who cannot join due to health reasons, they must inform their class teacher in writing and report to the General Office and they are to stay in the school library for self-study until the dismissal time, otherwise they might be considered as truancy.
- 4. For students who cannot join the School Picnic or come back to school for self study due to sickness, they must inform the school by phone before 8 a.m. in the morning and submit a parent's letter along with a valid medical certificate to the class teacher on or before 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2024. Otherwise, they might be considered as truancy.
- 5. For students who are late and cannot join, they must return to the school immediately and report to the General Office and go to the school library for study, otherwise, they will be considered as truancy.
- 6. Absence for the School Picnic without advanced permission obtained or valid reason(s) is considered as truancy. The penalty is a demerit.
- 7. Student must bring along their identity card.
- 8. Follow teachers' instructions at all times, listen to their announcements and note the time for departure and assembly. They must not go beyond the designated areas.
- 9. Any students who want to leave early after arrival, they must have the teachers' prior permission in advance.
- 10. If students have an accident, they must keep calm and inform their teachers as soon as possible.
- 11. Smoking and playing with fire are strictly forbidden.
- 12. Water activities (such as playing water in the beach, swimming, canoeing), roller-skating and gambling activities are not allowed.
- 13. Do not approach birds, bees, stray dogs,cats and wild animals.
- 14. If students find dead bird, avoid it and inform their teachers.
- 15. Do not damage plants, flowers and the environment.
- 16. Students must put on proper PE uniform and sports shoes.
- 17. Students must keep the environment clean, clear all litters before leaving the site. Always observe your behavior in the public.
- 18. Students must bring enough water drinking.
- 19. Be careful and do not endanger the safety of yourself and the others. Take good care of personal belongings.
- 20. Students are advised to consult the weather forecast before leaving home, bring an umbrella if necessary. If typhoon signal No.3 or the amber rainstorm signal is hoisted, the activity day will be cancelled. Friday class schedule will be commenced.
- 21. If typhoon signal No.8, the red or black rainstorm warning signal is hoisted, the School Picnic and all school activities will be cancelled.
