Dear Parents/Guardians,

In order to celebrate the upcoming Chinese New Year and let our student experience this festival culture, a series of program will be organized and February 10, 2025, will be assigned as our Chinese New Year Cultural Wear Day. Students can wear **Chinese Cultural Wear** or **casual wear with red colour** to school on that day. In addition, we would like to dedicate that day to raising funds for the needy. Your support will be highly appreciated. Please encourage your child to support this meaningful activity.

Details for wearing casual/cultural wear are as follows:

1. A donation of not less than \$20 is required for students who wear Chinese cultural wear or casual wear with red colour. Students can also put on school uniform.
2. Dress code for the day:
 - a) Apart from Chinese cultural wear/ casual wear with red colour, participants are required to abide by the school rules governing their appearance (for example, dyeing hair, make up are not allowed);
 - b) The attire must be suitable for students and must not attract undue attention:
 - Revealing or weird clothing is not allowed;
 - Punk trousers and clothes are not allowed;
 - Skirts are not allowed;
 - Muslim girls have to put on scarf, top with full sleeves;
 - No high heels
3. The donation must be given to the Donation box on the Chinese New Year Cultural Wear Day (February 10, 2025).
4. Students who fail to observe the above regulations will be dealt with accordingly. It's a regular school day with a normal timetable and attendance is compulsory.
